



## Dwight's Response

Hello Ima,

The auction I would advise is: 1S-P-1NT-P, 2D-P-2S-P, P-P.

Whenever you hold 2 cards (or more) in opener's major suit you should always take preference at the 2-level to the opening suit. Playing 2/1, Opener's bid of 2 of either minor shows only 3 of the suit. When you correct to 2 of the major you know you have a 7 card fit, the same as the diamond fit in this case. As responder you only pass or raise Openers minor suit rebid if you have 5 of that minor.
