The proceeds from beautiful scarves made by women in Cambodia go directly to the artisans.




70 people signed up to enjoy a day of learning and great comradery and fun. The funds raised will support a school in Cambodia for 4 months.

AED Demonstration

Thursday, Nov 14th at 11:00 a.m. at LBC

St. John Ambulance will demonstrate **Automated External Defibrillators** (AEDs) and help LBC members feel confident to use AEDs and perform CPR. AED's play a crucial role in treating sudden cardiac arrest (SCA); they are the only technology available to treat SCA's when they happen. By having a device onsite, you save treatment time and improve the survival odds of a victim by administering the AED before emergency first responders arrive. These devices are easy to use, lightweight, and portable. They are designed so that you can quickly take charge of the situation and improve the outcome. Remember, combined with CPR, an AED raises SCA survival by upward of 75%.


