Eight Is Enough Swiss Teams



Sunday, October 21, 2018 @ 1 p.m.

Unit Championship Rated

Entry Fee: \$40/team, includes pre-game snacks and coffee

Eight is Enough is a Swiss Teams format which evens the strength of the teams and gives everyone a greater chance to win. The game provides the opportunity to play with someone new and allows players who normally would not play in an open game the opportunity to be on a team with Flight A players!

Here's how **Eight Is Enough** works:

Each player is assigned a point value based on that player's total masterpoints. Each team consists of four players whose total point value does not exceed **8**.

- Flight C players with 0 - 200 masterpoints = 1 point
- Flight B players with 200 - 1000 masterpoints = 2 points
- Flight A players with 1000+ masterpoints = 3 points

For this game, we are specifying that each team **must** have **at least one Flight C player!**

This means that if two Flight A players want to play together, they will play with two Flight C players: 3 plus 3 plus 1 plus 1 equal 8.

A team may have a value of less than 8, but may not exceed 8. There are no restrictions to partnership combinations among team members.

NOTE: Registration is requested by Wednesday, October 17th. A minimum of five teams is required for the event to proceed.




Lost & Found on Hiatus


Our last day for **Lost and Found** this fall will be Monday, October 8th. Dwight Bender returns on Monday, December 10th. We look forward to seeing you then.


